Why hold a Club Membership?

Skaters that hold a full Club Membership receive a U.S. Figure Skating membership card, subscription to SKATING magazine, USFSA sports accident insurance, test achievement recognition, can skate on club ice, practice and take private lessons, compete at competitions and test at test sessions. Skaters with this type of membership have priority for ice shows and exhibitions. Full members can also vote in club events and at the General Meeting.

Why hold a Learn to Skate Membership?

Skaters that hold a Learn to Skate membership can enroll in Learn to Skate group classes, participate in ice shows with the LTS group, enjoy Learn to Skate parties and themed events.
