

Forestwood's Learn to Skate Etiquette

1. The Ice Monitor(s) are SafeSport certified and have full authority over all club sessions. Monitors are responsible for ensuring adherence to ice etiquette and have the power to remove anyone who does not comply. No refunds will be granted for violation of club rules.
2. All members are expected to set a positive example for new, prospective, and existing members, as well as guests of our rink. Please be friendly, welcoming, and willing to assist anyone unfamiliar with our facility and policies.
3. The club and its members are not liable for any lost items. If you find any belongings, please place them in the Lost and Found box located in the clubroom.
4. All skaters are to remain alert while skating. Skaters must look both ways before leaving the boards and keep their eyes up. Earbuds, headphones or ear plugs are not permitted to be worn on the ice in any capacity. All recording must be done from the boards.
5. Skaters are not permitted to congregate, chase, follow, coach, execute butt spins, sit, penguin slide, push, or engage in horseplay. Skaters and coaches should make an effort to utilize the entire ice surface during practice and avoid prolonged use of any single area.
6. No one is permitted to stand in the rink doorway. No one is permitted to sit in the hockey boxes (except coaches). No one may be on the ice without skates on.
7. Parents/Guardians/Skaters are not permitted to coach skaters from the stands or boards.
8. Forestwood has a zero-tolerance policy for any and all forms of abuse, as well as property destruction. Such behavior will result in a disciplinary review, which may lead to membership dismissal.
9. It is the privilege and responsibility for all members to keep the Club Room clean and sanitary.
10. At skating competitions, test sessions and events, remember that you are representing Forestwood Skating Club. It is vital that your conduct reflects positively on your club. Forestwood does not tolerate poor sportsmanship. As a Club, we are a team, and must strive to support all of our members and other participants of the sport.

I have received a copy of the ice pattern usage diagram and understand that it is my responsibility to make sure that my skater(s) fully understands the proper location for jumps, spins, edge moves and safety on the ice.

I acknowledge the SafeSport Program and its policies and agree to abide by all codes of conduct. I also understand that dangerous or negligent behavior during any Forestwood session, as well as failure to adhere to the Ice Etiquette rules, SafeSport Guidelines, and Parents Code of Conduct, may result in one or more of the following: a warning, suspension, a SafeSport Committee meeting, re-education on ice etiquette, SafeSport Guidelines, and the Parents Code of Conduct, or any combination, including dismissal of membership with no reimbursement of membership, ice, or any other fees.

The privilege of membership at Forestwood may be revoked or denied at any time, for any reason, if the board determines that a member's or prospective member's conduct is inconsistent with the mission of the organization or the best interests of the sport and its participants.
